

Creating Frames in Dreamweaver

Beginning with a New Web Page, Insert a Frame for Navigation.

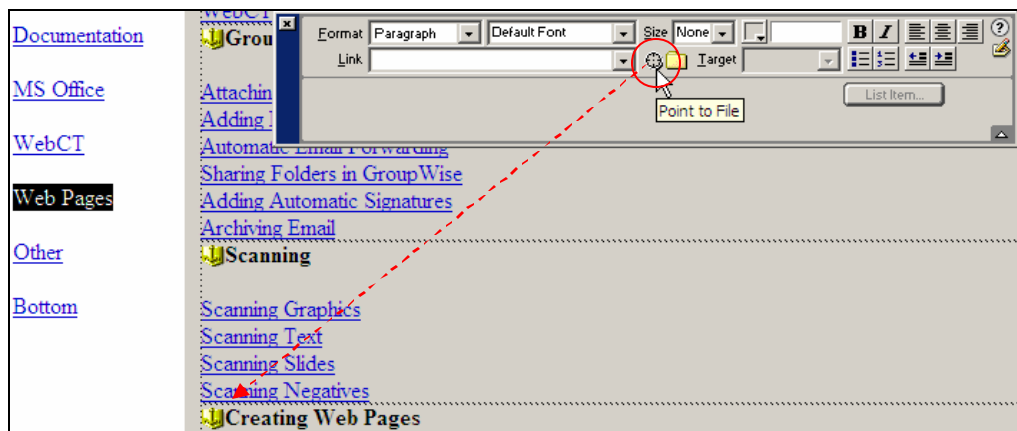
- File | New
- Insert | Frames | Left
 - Click in Left Frame
 - File | Save Frame As
 - Click in main or right Frame
 - File | Save Frame As

Open the page to which you are linking and create *Named Anchors* for each target location.

- File | Open
- Click in location to where you want to jump
- Insert | Invisible Tags | Named Anchor
- Save page

Create Hyperlinks in Navigation bar.

- Return to Frame document
- Open page with anchors in main frame
 - Click in Main Frame
 - File | Open in Frame
- Create links in navigation bar
 - Type link names in left frame
 - Highlight link name
 - When linking to an anchor on the page:
 - Click on the “Point to File” symbol and drag to the desired anchor.
 - Change the “Target” location to your main frame



- If linking to a new web page, click the browse folder in the properties box, locate and select the desired file.

Save all Frames.

- File | Save All Frames
